Poster presentations:

- 1. Only original research work is to be included in alignment with the theme. Thematic or review posters are not encouraged.
- 2. The poster should clearly include the rationale of the study, methodology, key results observed, final conclusion and future prospects.
- 3. The size of the poster is 2ft * 3ft in portrait mode only.
- 4. The duration of the poster presentation would be about 3 mins.
- 5. Certificate of participation will be provided.

Idea exposition event (Green-A-Thon):

- 1. Only original ideas are encouraged in alignment with the theme.
- 2. The team can consist between 1 to 3 members. Each individual member has to register for the event.
- 3. Participants from 16 to 40 yrs of age are encouraged for the event.
- 4. The idea should clearly state the novelty, the exact idea, implementation strategy, timelines, marketing strategy and financial projections (if applicable).

- 5. The duration of the presentation is 15mins. Participants are strictly advised to adhere to the time limit.
